"Readings are taken instantly in about half a second and users can take single readings or continuously scan surfaces to get specific spot readings and area-wide temperature ranges, including minimum, maximum and average readings," explains Chris Johnston of ennoLogic.

One user who wrote a five-star review of the ennoLogic IR thermometer, "...checked the accuracy of the thermometer by testing water heated to a specific temperature" and found it was "spot on." This user "was able to point the laser deep into the engine bay and check the temperature of the various hoses going to and from the radiator and water pump" while diagnosing problems with the cooling system in a vintage car.

Another user initially purchased the thermometer to find "all the air leaks around doors and windows" that drive up air-conditioning and heating costs. However, after closing the gaps around windows and doors with the help of the infrared thermometer, the same user was able to verify the effectiveness of installing insulating foil to keep heat out of the attic. After the installation, the temperature gun revealed a "30-degree difference" between the finished and unfinished section of the attic exposed to afternoon sun.

The IR thermometer also got rave reviews from customers measuring barbecue grills, stove-tops, oven and pizza stone temperatures. Many customers remarked on the accuracy of the thermometer for measuring cooking surfaces such as cast-iron skillets and fry pans.
